They seemed to realize that we are more than just a “group of white-haired collectors and hoarders reminiscing about the past in a musty environment.” We are preserving the city’s soul.

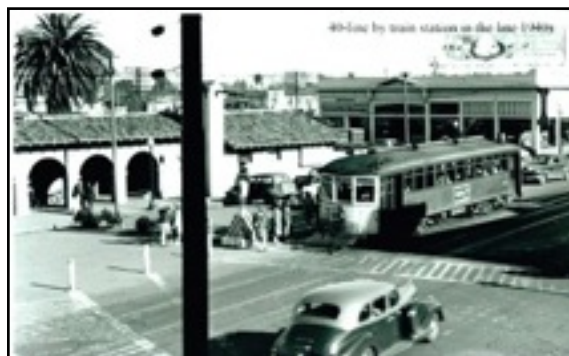
